Meeting Records:

Elizabeth O'Malley welcomed the delegation, explained that this gathering is a technical working session to further the agreed upon related action items from the last JCCRM meeting held in Miami, FL in December 1997.

Adrian Goldschmidt provided some background information regarding the production of Mo-99 and the proposed use Crystalline Silicotitanates (CST) for the removal of Cesium from the active waste produced during the production of Mo99.

A technical discussion between the CNEA and DOE delegations followed which examined the options and processes in more detail. CNEA provided information on the process of how they will proceed to generate data and information required for design of waste treatment process.

Action Items:

DOE and CNEA officials agreed to establish tests and procedures for the demonstration of the waste treatment process with synthetic waste solutions at CNEA's facility in Argentina.


Upon completion of the demonstration with synthetic waste solutions, DOE and CNEA will cooperate to evaluate generated data and determine feasibility of establishment of tests with actual radioactive materials (hot tests) at CNEA facilities in Argentina.

Exchange of information will be conducted through the use of teleconferences, e-mail, and scientist exchanges when deemed appropriate by the DOE and CNEA officials. It is

confirmed that related information will be transmitted prior to any teleconference scheduled.


All information transmitted will be done through the DOE International Office. A representative of the DOE International Office will be present on all teleconferences.
